By letter dated February 4, 2014, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and directed to furnish additional information no later than February 18, 2014, including:

1. a complete copy of the current insurance policy for each vehicle in applicant's possession, custody, or control;
2. a complete 3-year insurance-claims experience report for each vehicle in applicant's possession, custody, or control;
3. a statement indicating when applicant's affiliate On The Go Transportation, Inc., ceased operations in 2013 and whether On The Go has recommenced operations at any time since then; and
4. copies of business records from January 1, 2013, to February 4, 2014.

The letter cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information would result in delay or dismissal of the application.

Applicant has yet to produce Items 1 and 4. The response to Item 2 is illegible. The response to Item 3 does not address whether On The Go has recommenced operations.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.<sup>1</sup> An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full

and fair determination of the application.<sup>2</sup> Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.<sup>3</sup>

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of Your Way Transportation Inc. for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
