By email dated February 21, 2014, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and directed to furnish a certificate of good standing from its state of formation no later than March 7, 2014. The letter cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information would result in delay or dismissal of the application. Applicant submitted a certificate of good standing on February 27, 2014, but the certificate is in the name of District of Columbia Care Center Inc., not DC Care Center, Inc.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair determination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of DC Care Center, Inc., for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
