Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 369 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1 million, excess-of-\$500,000, WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on July 1, 2014, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 369 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$100 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 14,890, served July 1, 2014.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$4.5 million, excess-of-\$500,000, WMATC Insurance Endorsement on July 2, 2014, and tendered a \$100 check on July 9, 2014. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
