By application filed July 24, 2014, Car Plus Transportation LLC seeks to add a 15-person seating capacity restriction to WMATC Certificate of Authority No. 2054.

Certificate No. 2054 is currently suspended for applicant's failure to maintain on file with the Commission proof of \$5 million in commercial vehicle liability insurance, as required by Commission Regulation No. 58 for carriers with unrestricted certificates of authority.¹

Adding the seating capacity restriction to Certificate No. 2054 would confine applicant's operations to vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons, including the driver, thereby reducing from \$5 million to \$1.5 million applicant's minimum insurance obligation under Commission Regulation No. 58.

Under Regulation No. 54-08, the Executive Director may approve an application to add a seating capacity restriction to a certificate of authority. In support of its application, applicant has submitted evidence that its fleet consists solely of vehicles seating 15 or fewer persons, including the driver. Accordingly, the application shall be approved.

Applicant is admonished that it may not recommence WMATC operations unless and until the Commission has issued an order lifting the suspension of Certificate No. 2054.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That upon applicant's timely compliance with the requirements of this order, Certificate of Authority No. 2054 shall be reissued, as amended consistent with this order, to Car Plus Transportation LLC, 507 Florida Avenue, N.E., Washington, DC 20002-3439.

2. That applicant may not transport passengers for hire between points in the Metropolitan District pursuant to this order unless and until Certificate of Authority No. 2054 has been reissued in accordance with the preceding paragraph and the suspension of Certificate No. 2054 has been lifted by Commission order.

3. That applicant is hereby directed to present its revenue vehicle(s) for inspection and file the following documents on or before August 4, 2014: (a) evidence of insurance pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 58; (b) an original and four copies of a tariff or tariffs in accordance with Commission Regulation No. 55; (c) a vehicle list stating the year, make, model, serial number, fleet number, license plate number (with jurisdiction) and seating capacity of each vehicle to be used in revenue operations; (d) a copy of the for-hire vehicle registration card, and a lease as required by Commission Regulation No. 62 if applicant is not the registered owner, for each vehicle to be used in revenue operations; (e) proof of current safety inspection of said vehicle(s) by or on behalf of the United States Department of Transportation, the State of Maryland, the District of Columbia, or the Commonwealth of Virginia; (f) the original Certificate of Authority No. 2054; and (g) in accordance with WMATC Rule No. 28, a statement under oath indicating whether applicant ceased all WMATC operations on and after January 31, 2014.

4. That the approval of amendment herein shall be void and the application shall stand denied upon applicant's failure to timely satisfy the conditions of reissuance prescribed herein.
