On July 12, 2014, Commission Regulation No. 58 required respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 1753 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and to maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of such coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum. Certificate No. 1753 became automatically suspended on July 12, 2014, under Regulation No. 58-12 when the \$5 million primary WMATC Endorsement on file for respondent terminated without replacement.

Order No. 14,913, issued in this proceeding on July 14, 2014, noted the automatic suspension of Certificate No. 1753, directed respondent to cease transporting passengers for hire under Certificate No. 1753, and gave respondent 30 days to file the necessary WMATC Endorsement(s) and pay the \$100 late fee due under Regulation No. 67-03(c) or face revocation of Certificate No. 1753.

Later that same day, the Commission issued Order No. 14,915 conditionally approving respondent's application to add a 15-person seating capacity restriction to Certificate No. 1753.<sup>1</sup> Adding the seating capacity restriction to Certificate No. 1753 confines respondent's operations to vehicles with a seating capacity of 15 persons or less, including the driver, and reduces to \$1.5 million respondent's minimum insurance obligation under Commission Regulation No. 58.

The conditions of approval in Order No. 14,915 included the requirement that respondent file one or more WMATC Endorsements showing \$1.5 million in coverage. Respondent filed a \$1.5 million WMATC Endorsement on July 28, 2014, with an effective date of July 12, 2014. Respondent has satisfied the other conditions of approval, as well, and Certificate No. 1753 has been reissued this day as amended consistent with the terms of Order No. 14,915.

In addition, respondent has paid the \$100 late fee due under Regulation No. 67-03(c), and respondent has verified in writing timely cessation of operations as required by Commission Rule No. 28.

Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
