Certificate No. 1814 was automatically suspended on May 3, 2014, pursuant to Regulation No. 67-04 for respondent's failure to pay on or before May 2, 2014, \$300 in late fees incurred under Regulation No. 67-03(a) and (b) for failing to file an annual report on time and failing to pay an annual fee on time.

Order No. 14,753, served May 7, 2014, gave respondent 30 days to pay said fees (as detailed in the appendix to that order) or face revocation of Certificate No. 1814. Respondent has yet to respond.¹

Certificate No. 1814 shall be revoked accordingly pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with Commission Regulation No. 67 and Commission Order No. 14,753. The \$300 in late fees shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1814 is hereby revoked.
2. That \$300 in late fees shall remain due under Regulation No. 67.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and

c. surrender Certificate of Authority No. 1814 to the
Commission.
