Case No. MP-2014-081

Certificate No. 2115 was automatically suspended in Case No. MP-2014-071 on May 2, 2014, as a result of respondent's failure to file a 2014 annual report under Regulation No. 60-01 and pay a \$150 annual fee under Regulation No. 67-02, respectively, on or before May 1, 2014.

In addition, Certificate No. 2115 was further suspended on May 3, 2014, pursuant to Regulation No. 67-04 as a result of respondent's failure to pay on or before May 2, 2014, \$300 in associated late fees under Regulation No. 67-03(a) and (b) for failing to file an annual report on time and failing to pay an annual fee on time.

Order No. 14,753, served May 7, 2014, gave respondent until June 6, 2014, to file the annual report and pay said fees (as detailed in the appendix to that order) or face revocation of Certificate No. 2115. Respondent has yet to respond.

In the meantime, Certificate No. 2115 was further suspended in Case No. MP-2014-081 on May 20, 2014, pursuant to Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$100 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), when the \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated without replacement. Order No. 14,782, served May 20, 2014, gave respondent until June 19, 2014, to file the necessary WMATC Endorsement(s) and pay the \$100 late insurance fee or face revocation of Certificate No. 2115. Respondent has yet to respond.

Certificate No. 2115 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with Commission Regulation Nos. 58, 60, and 67 and Commission

Order Nos. 14,753 and 14,782. The annual report and \$550 in unpaid fees shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Case Nos. MP-2014-071 and MP-2014-081 are hereby consolidated under Rule No. 20-02.
2. That Certificate of Authority No. 2115 is hereby revoked.
3. That respondent's 2014 annual report and \$550 in fees shall remain due under Regulation Nos. 60 and 67, respectively.
4. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate of Authority No. 2115 to the Commission.
