This matter is before the Commission on respondent's response to Order No. 15,068, served September 18, 2014.

The order gave respondent 30 days to show cause why the Commission should not assess a civil forfeiture against respondent, and/or suspend or revoke Certificate No. 749, for knowingly and willfully violating Article XI, Section 6(a), of the Compact, Regulation No. 58, and the orders issued in this proceeding.

On October 21, 2014, respondent submitted a request for a 14 day extension of the show cause deadline.

Under Commission Rule No. 7-05: "Except when fixed by statute, whenever by any . . . order of the Commission, . . . an act is required or allowed to be done at or in a specified time, the time fixed or the period of time prescribed may for good cause be extended by the Executive Director"

The deadline at issue is not fixed by statute. As for good cause, respondent states that it recently hired counsel to prepare a response to Order No. 15,068 and that counsel needs additional time to prepare a proper response. This is the first request for an extension of the show cause deadline.

For good cause shown, the October 20 deadline shall be extended to November 3, 2014. No further extensions shall be granted.
