Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 2428 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on November 1, 2014. A replacement WMATC Endorsement had been filed earlier on October 7, 2014, but the insured's address on the endorsement did not match the address on file with the Commission as required by Regulation No. 58-04(b). As a result, Certificate No. 2428 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$100 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 15,171, served November 3, 2014.¹

Respondent filed an acceptable \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on November 3, 2014, and tendered a \$100 check on November 6, 2014. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
