Certificate No. 1865 has been suspended since October 24, 2014, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 15,150, served October 24, 2014, noted that Certificate No. 1865 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late fee within thirty days. Respondent has yet to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay the late fee. Accordingly, Certificate No. 1865 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1865 is hereby revoked.
2. That the \$100 late insurance fee shall remain due in accordance with Regulation No. 67.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 1865 to the Commission.
