Certificate No. 398 was revoked in Order No. 15,060, served September 18, 2014, pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to pay a \$150 late fee incurred under Regulation No. 67-03(a) for failing to file an annual report on time. Respondent subsequently paid the late fee and has requested reinstatement of Certificate No. 398.

Under Title II of the Compact, Article XIII, Section 4(a), an application for reconsideration of a Commission order must be filed within 30 days of its publication and state specifically the errors claimed as grounds for reconsideration. Respondent timely filed its reinstatement request on September 29, 2014, but the request does not allege any error on the part of the Commission. Reconsideration, therefore, is denied.

However, considering that respondent has paid all outstanding late fees, we will reopen this proceeding on our own initiative<sup>1</sup> and reinstate Certificate of Authority No. 398.<sup>2</sup>
