Certificate No. 1904 was revoked in Order No. 15,063, served September 18, 2014, pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to file a 2014 annual report under Regulation No. 60-01, pay a \$150 annual fee under Regulation No. 67-02, and pay \$300 in associated late fees under Regulation No. 67-03(a),(b) on or before June 6, 2014. Respondent subsequently filed the report and paid the fees and has requested reinstatement of Certificate No. 1904.

Under Title II of the Compact, Article XIII, Section 4(a), an application for reconsideration of a Commission order must be filed within 30 days of its publication and state specifically the errors claimed as grounds for reconsideration. Respondent timely filed its reinstatement request on October 2, 2014, but the request does not allege any error on the part of the Commission. Reconsideration, therefore, is denied.

However, considering that respondent has filed a complete 2014 annual report and paid all outstanding fees, we will reopen this proceeding on our own initiative¹ and reinstate Certificate of Authority No. 1904.²
