Certificate No. 501 was automatically suspended on October 1, 2014, for the willful failure of The Arc of the District of Columbia, Inc., (respondent), to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 15,093, served October 1, 2014, noted that Certificate No. 501 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late fee within 30 days. Respondent subsequently tendered a \$100 online credit card payment and filed an application requesting voluntary termination of Certificate No. 501.

The Executive Director may approve an application for voluntary termination under Regulation No. 54-08, provided the applicant is in good standing with the Commission.<sup>1</sup> Inasmuch as no fees or reports are currently due from respondent, and respondent therefore is in good standing, the application shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 501 is hereby terminated, effective this date.

2. That within 30 days from the date of this order The Arc of the District of Columbia, Inc., shall:

- a. remove from its vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
- b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and

c. surrender Certificate No. 501 to the Commission.
