Certificate No. 1897 has been suspended since January 27, 2015, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 15,354, served January 27, 2015, noted that Certificate No. 1897 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late fee within thirty days. Respondent has yet to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay the late fee. Accordingly, Certificate No. 1897 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

In accordance with Commission Regulation Nos. 60 and 67, the \$100 late insurance fee, respondent's unpaid \$150 annual fee for 2015, and unfiled annual report for 2015 shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1897 is hereby revoked.
2. That respondent's 2015 annual report and \$250 in unpaid fees shall remain due in accordance with Regulation Nos. 60 and 67.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 1897 to the Commission.
