Case No. MP-2015-034

Certificate No. 1728 has been suspended since February 22, 2015, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 15,411, served February 23, 2015, noted that Certificate No. 1728 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late fee within 30 days. Respondent has yet to file the necessary endorsement(s) and pay the late fee.

Regulation No. 58-15 provides that upon a carrier's failure to timely comply with a suspension order issued under Regulation No. 58-12, and as soon as practicable thereafter, the Executive Director shall issue an order revoking the carrier's operating authority or refer the matter for consideration by the Commissioners. Given the absence of any response, Certificate No. 1728 shall be revoked.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1728 is hereby revoked.
2. That the \$100 late insurance fee and respondent's unpaid \$150 annual fee for 2015, unfiled annual report for 2015, and \$300 in associated late fees shall remain due in accordance with Regulation Nos. 60 and 67.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 1728 to the Commission.
