Case No. MP-2015-040

Certificate No. 2111 has been suspended since March 3, 2015, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 15,428, served March 3, 2015, noted that Certificate No. 2111 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late fee within thirty days. Respondent has yet to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay the late fee.

Regulation No. 58-15 provides that upon a carrier's failure to timely comply with a suspension order issued under Regulation No. 58-12, and as soon as practicable thereafter, the Executive Director shall issue an order revoking the carrier's operating authority or refer the matter for consideration by the Commissioners. Considering that respondent has neither filed the necessary insurance endorsement(s) nor paid the late fee, Certificate No. 2111 shall be revoked.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 2111 is hereby revoked.
2. That the \$100 late insurance fee shall remain due in accordance with Regulation No. 67.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 2111 to the Commission.
