Case No. MP-2015-043

Certificate No. 749 has been suspended since March 7, 2015, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 15,444, served March 9, 2015, noted that Certificate No. 749 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late fee within thirty days. Respondent has filed the necessary insurance endorsement(s) but has yet to pay the late fee.

Regulation No. 58-15 provides that upon a carrier's failure to timely comply with a suspension order issued under Regulation No. 58-12, and as soon as practicable thereafter, the Executive Director shall issue an order revoking the carrier's operating authority or refer the matter for consideration by the Commissioners. Considering that more than 30 days has passed, and respondent has not paid the late fee and has not explained the failure to do so, Certificate No. 749 shall be revoked.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 749 is hereby revoked.
2. That the \$100 late insurance fee shall remain due in accordance with Regulation No. 67.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
  - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
  - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
  - c. surrender Certificate No. 749 to the Commission.
