Certificate No. 2457 was automatically suspended on April 17, 2015, for the willful failure of Frehiywot Tuloro to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 15,529, served April 17, 2015, noted that Certificate No. 2457 would be subject to revocation if Mr. Tuloro failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late fee within 30 days. On April 21, 2015, Mr. Tuloro paid the late fee and filed an application for voluntary termination of Certificate No. 2457.

The Executive Director may approve an application for voluntary termination under Regulation No. 54-08, provided the applicant is in good standing with the Commission.¹ Inasmuch as no fees or reports are currently due from Mr. Tuloro, and Mr. Tuloro therefore is in good standing, the application shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 2457 is hereby terminated, effective this date.

2. That within 30 days from the date of this order applicant shall:

- a. remove from applicant's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
- b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
- c. surrender Certificate No. 2457 to the Commission.
