Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 2409 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on April 19, 2015, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 2409 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$100 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 15,534, served April 20, 2015. The order also directed respondent to pay a \$150 late fee for failing to file its 2015 annual report in timely fashion.

Respondent paid the annual-report late fee on April 29, 2015, and tendered an acceptable \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement and payment of the insurance late fee on May 28, 2015. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted in accordance with Regulation No. 58-13, and this investigation is terminated.
