Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 1630 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The Commission issued Order No. 15,644 on June 5, 2015, announcing the automatic suspension of Certificate No. 1630 under Regulation No. 58-12 when it appeared that the \$5 million WMATC Insurance Endorsement filed on respondent's behalf by Canal Insurance Company on April 28, 2015, covering the period from April 28, 2015, to April 28, 2016, under Policy No. PIA08088701, had been canceled by Canal on May 6, 2015, effective June 5, 2015.

On June 9, 2015, the Commission discovered that the May 6 cancellation notice pertains to a different WMATC Endorsement, one for the period from April 28, 2014, to April 28, 2015, under Policy No. PIP00203001.

Under the circumstances, it appears that Order No. 15,644 was issued in error. Order No. 15,644 shall accordingly be rescinded and the suspension vacated.¹
