Certificate No. 1898 was automatically suspended on May 1, 2015, pursuant to Regulation No. 67-04 as a result of respondent's failure to pay \$300 in late fees incurred under Regulation No. 67-03(a), (b) on or before April 30, 2015.

Order No. 15,565, served May 5, 2015, gave respondent 30 days to pay \$300 in late fees or face revocation of Certificate No. 1898. Respondent has yet to comply. Accordingly, Certificate No. 1898 shall be revoked pursuant to Regulation No. 67-09(a). The \$300 in late fees shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1898 is hereby revoked.
2. That \$300 in late fees shall remain due under Regulation No. 67.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate of Authority No. 1898 to the Commission.
