Certificate No. 2522 has been suspended under Regulation No. 58-12 since June 10, 2015,¹ for respondent's willful failure to maintain compliance with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 15,670, served June 10, 2015, noted that Certificate No. 2522 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late fee within thirty days. Respondent has yet to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay the late fee. Accordingly, Certificate No. 2522 shall be revoked pursuant to Regulation No. 58-15(a).

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 2522 is hereby revoked.
2. That the \$100 late insurance fee shall remain due in accordance with Regulation No. 67.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 2522 to the Commission.
