Commission Regulation No. 60-01 provides that each carrier holding a certificate of authority on the first day of the calendar year shall file an annual report on or before January 31 of that year. Because January 31 fell on a Saturday this year, the January 31 deadline was automatically extended to Monday, February 2, by operation of Rule No. 7-01.

Respondent held Certificate of Authority No. 2322 on January 1, 2015, but failed to comply with Regulation No. 60-01 on or before February 2. As a result, respondent was automatically assessed a \$150 late fee pursuant to Regulation No. 67-03(a).

Respondent filed a petition to waive the late fee on April 27, 2015. While the petition was pending, the Commission issued Order No. 15,565, on May 5, 2015. The order noted the automatic suspension of Certificate No. 2322 pursuant to Regulation No. 67-04 for respondent's failure to pay the late fee on or before April 30, 2015. The order declared that Certificate No. 2322 would be subject to revocation pursuant to Regulation No. 67-09(a) if respondent did not pay the late fee within 30 days.

The Commission later denied respondent's petition in Order No. 15,737, served July 15, 2015, and directed the Executive Director to issue an order revoking Certificate No. 2322 if respondent failed to pay the \$150 late fee within 30 days. Respondent has yet to pay the late fee. Accordingly, Certificate No. 2322 shall be revoked pursuant to Regulation No. 67-09(a) and Order No. 15,737. The late fee shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 2322 is hereby revoked.
2. That the \$150 late-report fee shall remain due in accordance with Regulation No. 67.

3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:

- a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
- b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
- c. surrender Certificate of Authority No. 2322 to the Commission.
