Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 2268 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

Regulation No. 58-12 provides for automatic suspension of operating authority upon a carrier's failure to maintain compliance with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Under Regulation No. 67-03(c), \$100 is due and payable upon the failure of a carrier to timely file an acceptable WMATC Insurance Endorsement.

The \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent expired on July 9, 2015. As of that date, WMATC had received a new \$1.5 million primary endorsement, but WMATC had not received any endorsement(s) for the remaining \$3.5 million in coverage required by Regulation No 58.

Order No. 15,722, served July 9, 2015, noted that Certificate No. 2268 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late fee within 30 days. Respondent paid the \$100 late fee on July 14, 2015, but has yet to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s).¹ Accordingly, Certificate No. 2268 shall be revoked pursuant to Regulation No. 58-15(a).

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 2268 is hereby revoked.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:

¹ Respondent filed an application on July 14, 2015, seeking to add a 15-person seating capacity restriction to Certificate No. 2268, thereby reducing from \$5 million to \$1.5 million applicant's minimum insurance obligation under Commission Regulation No. 58. The application was conditionally approved on July 15, 2015, in Order No. 15,740, but applicant failed to satisfy the conditions for issuance of operating authority within the time allowed, thereby voiding the Commission's approval.

- a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
- b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
- c. surrender Certificate No. 2268 to the Commission.
