Certificate No. 1540 was automatically suspended on September 1, 2015, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 15,836, served September 1, 2015, noted that Certificate No. 1540 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late fee within 30 days. Respondent paid the \$100 late fee online on September 10, 2015, and filed an application on September 14, 2015, requesting voluntary termination of Certificate No. 1540.

The Executive Director may approve an application for voluntary termination under Regulation No. 54-08, provided the applicant is in good standing with the Commission.¹ Inasmuch as no fees or reports are currently due from MarcParc Inc., and MarcParc Inc. therefore is in good standing, the application shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1540 is hereby terminated, effective this date.

2. That within 30 days from the date of this order applicant shall:

- a. remove from applicant's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
- b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
- c. surrender Certificate No. 1540 to the Commission.
