By application filed September 21, 2015, Sheba Network, LLC, trading as Sheba, seeks voluntary termination of Certificate No. 2368.

The Executive Director may approve an application for voluntary termination under Regulation No. 54-08(d). The application shall be denied if applicant is not in good standing with the Commission.¹

Applicant was assessed a \$250 civil forfeiture in Order No. 15,591, on May 15, 2015.² Applicant has yet to pay the forfeiture. Consequently, applicant is not in good standing.

Until such time as applicant is in good standing with the Commission, the request for voluntary termination shall not be approved.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the application of Sheba Network, LLC, trading as Sheba, for voluntary termination of Certificate No. 2368 is hereby denied without prejudice.
