Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 1431 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The Commission issued Order No. 15,877 on October 1, 2015, announcing the automatic suspension of Certificate No. 1431 under Regulation No. 58-12 when it appeared that the \$1 million primary and \$4 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements filed on respondent's behalf on September 16, 2014, by The Travelers Indemnity Company of Connecticut and The Travelers Property Casualty Company of America, respectively, had terminated without replacement.

On October 14, 2015, the Commission discovered that new \$1 million primary and \$4 million excess WMATC Endorsements had been filed on respondent's behalf by The Travelers Indemnity Company of Connecticut on September 10, 2015, with an effective date of October 1, 2015, and an expiration date of October 1, 2016.

Under the circumstances, it appears that Order No. 15,877 was issued in error. Order No. 15,877 shall accordingly be rescinded and the suspension vacated.¹
