By application filed September 9, 2015, applicant seeks a certificate of authority to transport passengers in irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District, restricted to transportation in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Under Regulation No. 67-01, all applications for irregular route authority must be accompanied by a \$300 filing fee. The \$300 credit card payment tendered by applicant on September 9, 2015, was retracted on November 5, 2015.

Applicant's failure to pay the filing fee constitutes a failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements. Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.<sup>1</sup>

In addition, applicant now owes a \$25 dishonored payment fee under Regulation No. 67-07.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the application of Our City Transportation L.L.C. for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.

2. That the \$25 dishonored payment fee shall remain due.
