By email dated October 7, 2015, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and directed to furnish additional information no later than October 21, 2015, including an explanation of why approving this application would be consistent with the public interest when applicant has not complied with Order No. 15,640 issued in Case No. MP-2015-067. The email cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information would result in delay or dismissal of the application. Applicant submitted a response on October 8, 2015, but the response does not address applicant's failure to submit a vehicle marking removal affidavit and supporting photos in compliance with Order No. 15,640.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair determination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of Casablancaexpress Limo, L.L.C., for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
