Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 810 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on November 14, 2015. A new endorsement was filed on November 13, 2015, but it was filed with an unacceptable address. As a result, Certificate No. 810 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$100 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 15,977, served November 17, 2015.

Respondent paid the late fee and filed a change of address notice on December 22, 2015. The \$1.5 million WMATC Insurance Endorsement filed November 13, 2015, is now acceptable. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted in accordance with Regulation No. 58-13, and this investigation is terminated.
