By application filed January 14, 2016, LIG Transportation LLC seeks voluntary termination of Certificate No. 2730. The application was accompanied by the original Certificate No. 2730, issued July 27, 2015.

The Executive Director may approve an application for voluntary termination under Regulation No. 54-08, provided the applicant is in good standing with the Commission.¹ Applicant has yet to comply with the Commission's 2016 annual fee requirement.² Voluntary termination has been denied in the past under such circumstances.³ In addition, applicant was assessed a \$100 late insurance fee in Order No. 16,145, on January 19, 2016.⁴ Applicant has yet to pay the fee. Consequently, applicant is not in good standing.

Until such time as applicant has paid all outstanding fees under Regulation No. 67, the request for voluntary termination shall not be approved.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the application of LIG Transportation LLC for voluntary termination of Certificate No. 2730 is hereby denied without prejudice.
