By application filed February 2, 2016, WMATC Carrier No. 280 requests that the name on its certificate of authority be changed from Veolia Transportation Services, Inc., to Transdev Services, Inc.

Under Regulation No. 54-08, the Executive Director may approve an application to change a legal name not involving a transfer of authority. Legal name applications shall include proof of legal change.

Applicant is a Maryland corporation. The application is supported by contemporaneous proof that articles of amendment changing applicant's legal name from Veolia Transportation Services, Inc., to Transdev Services, Inc., have been filed with and accepted by the Maryland Department of Assessments and Taxation.¹

Accordingly, the application shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That upon applicant's timely compliance with the requirements of this order, Certificate of Authority No. 280 shall be reissued to Transdev Services, Inc., 720 E. Butterfield Road, #300, Lombard, IL 60148-5601.

2. That applicant may not transport passengers for hire between points in the Metropolitan District pursuant to this order unless and until applicant's certificate of authority has been reissued as amended in accordance with this order.

3. That applicant is hereby directed to present its revenue vehicle(s) for inspection and file the following documents within the 180-day maximum permitted in Commission Regulation No. 66: (a) evidence of insurance pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 58; (b) an

original and four copies of a tariff or tariffs in accordance with Commission Regulation No. 55; (c) a vehicle list stating the year, make, model, serial number, fleet number, license plate number (with jurisdiction) and seating capacity of each vehicle to be used in revenue operations; (d) a copy of the for-hire vehicle registration card, and a lease as required by Commission Regulation No. 62 if applicant is not the registered owner, for each vehicle to be used in revenue operations; and (e) proof of current safety inspection of said vehicle(s) by or on behalf of the United States Department of Transportation, the State of Maryland, the District of Columbia, or the Commonwealth of Virginia.

4. That the approval of amendment herein shall be void and the application shall stand denied upon applicant's failure to timely satisfy the conditions of reissuance prescribed herein.
