Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 2487 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The Commission issued Order No. 16,160 on January 27, 2016, announcing the automatic suspension of Certificate No. 2487 under Regulation No. 58-12 when it appeared that the \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement filed on respondent's behalf on April 3, 2015, by Global Liberty Insurance Company of New York had terminated without replacement.

On February 12, 2016, the Commission discovered that a new \$1.5 million primary WMATC Endorsement had been filed on respondent's behalf by Global Liberty Insurance Company of New York on January 22, 2016, with an effective date of January 23, 2016, and an expiration date of January 23, 2017.

Under the circumstances, it appears that Order No. 16,160 was issued in error. Order No. 16,160 shall accordingly be rescinded and the suspension vacated.<sup>1</sup>
