Regulation No. 67-04 provides that a carrier's operating authority shall stand suspended upon the carrier's failure to pay an annual fee or late fee assessed pursuant to Regulation No. 67-03 on or before April 30 of the year the fee is due.

The Commission issued Order No. 16,325 on May 3, 2016, announcing the automatic suspension of Certificate No. 2721 when it appeared that respondent had not yet paid its \$175 annual fee for 2016 or \$300 in late fees assessed pursuant to Regulation No. 67-03.

On May 9, 2016, the Commission discovered that respondent paid \$475 online on April 25, 2016.

Under the circumstances, it appears that Order No. 16,325 was issued to respondent in error. The portion of Order No. 16,325 applicable to respondent shall accordingly be rescinded and the suspension vacated.¹
