By email dated April 18, 2016, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and directed to furnish additional information no later than May 2, 2016, including a statement explaining why applicant's address does not match the address on file with USDOT and does not match the address for applicant's affiliate, Nationwide Chauffeured Services LLC. The email cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information would result in delay or dismissal of the application. Applicant has yet to submit said statement.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.<sup>1</sup> An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair determination of the application.<sup>2</sup> Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.<sup>3</sup>

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of Nationwide Sedan Services LLC for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
