Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 2302 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum. Under Regulation No. 67-03(c), \$100 is due and payable upon the failure of a carrier to timely file an acceptable WMATC Insurance Endorsement.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent was canceled on May 5, 2016, effective June 5, 2016, and has not been replaced. Certificate No. 2302, therefore, is automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12 and may be revoked if respondent fails to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) and pay the \$100 late fee within 30 days.

Certificate No. 2302 already stands suspended and subject to revocation for respondent's failure to file a 2016 annual report and pay an associated \$150 late fee on or before April 30, 2016.¹

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That respondent shall not transport passengers for hire under Certificate No. 2302, unless and until otherwise ordered by the Commission.

2. That within 30 days, respondent shall file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s), submit a 2016 annual report, and pay the sum of \$250 by money order, check, or online by credit card, or show cause why Certificate No. 2302 should not be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.
