By email dated January 22, 2016, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and directed to furnish additional information no later than February, 5 2016, including a list of shareholders, or in other words, a list of owners. The email cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information would result in delay or dismissal of the application. Applicant has yet to produce a list of its owners.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair determination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of 3MH Services Ltd. for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
