Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 444 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1 million primary and \$4 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent terminated on October 1, 2016, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 444 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$100 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 16,599, served October 3, 2016.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$1 million primary and \$4 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on October 3, 2016, and tendered a \$100 check on October 12, 2016. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted in accordance with Regulation No. 58-13, and this investigation is terminated.
