By email dated September 20, 2016, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and, pursuant to Regulation No. 54-04(b), directed to furnish additional information no later than October 4, 2016, including a list of applicant's officers and a list of applicant's owners, along with a current mailing address and telephone number for each officer and each owner. The email cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information would result in delay or dismissal of the application. Applicant has yet to produce said lists.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.<sup>1</sup> An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair determination of the application.<sup>2</sup> Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.<sup>3</sup>

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of Et Tran, L.L.C., for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
