Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 310 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

On October 1, 2015, the \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent expired without having been fully replaced by one or more WMATC Endorsements. WMATC had received a replacement endorsement on September 28, 2015, in the amount of \$1 million, but WMATC had received no endorsement(s) for the remaining \$500,000 in coverage required by Regulation No 58. This came to WMATC staff's attention on October 3, 2016, when the \$1 million endorsement filed September 28, 2015, expired without replacement on October 1, 2016. As a result, Certificate No. 310 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$100 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 16,597, served October 3, 2016.

On October 6, 2016, respondent filed an acceptable replacement \$1 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement with an effective date of October 1, 2016. On October 20, 2016, respondent filed an acceptable \$500,000 excess WMATC Insurance Endorsement covering the period October 1, 2015 through October 1, 2016, and a second acceptable \$500,000 excess WMATC Insurance Endorsement with an effective date of October 1, 2016. Respondent also tendered a \$100 online credit card payment on October 20, 2016. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted in accordance with Regulation No. 58-13, and this investigation is terminated.
