Certificate No. 1665 was terminated at applicant's request in Order No. 16,674, served November 10, 2016, pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(b), of the Compact. Respondent thereafter filed a request seeking reinstatement.

Under Article XIII, Section 4(a) of the Compact, a party to a proceeding affected by a final order or decision of the Commission may file within 30 days of its publication a written application requesting Commission reconsideration of the matter involved, and stating specifically the errors claimed as grounds for reconsideration.

Applicant timely filed its request for reinstatement on November 21, 2016, but the application does not allege any error on the part of the Commission. The application therefore is denied.

However, considering that an effective tariff and effective WMATC Insurance Endorsements totaling \$5 million are on file for applicant, and were on file as of November 21, 2016, we will reopen this proceeding on our own initiative and reinstate Certificate of Authority No. 1665.¹
