This matter is before the Commission on applicant's request for an extension of time to comply with Commission Order No. 16,554, served September 7, 2016.

The order conditionally granted Certificate of Authority No. 2947 and stipulated that applicant would have the full 180 days available under Commission Regulation No. 66, or until March 6, 2017, under Rule No. 7-01, to satisfy the conditions of the grant. The order further stipulated that the grant of authority would be void and the application would stand denied upon applicant's failure to timely satisfy the conditions of issuance. Applicant failed to satisfy the conditions for issuance of operating authority within the time allotted, thereby voiding the Commission's approval as of March 7, 2017.

On March 27, 2017, applicant requested an extension of the March 6, 2017, deadline.

Regulation No. 66-01 states: "Except as provided in Regulation No. 66-02, the time for complying with the conditions of a grant of authority shall not be extended beyond 180 days from the date of the grant. A conditional grant of authority shall be void on the 181st day following the date of the grant if full compliance has not been achieved at that time." Regulation No. 66-02 states: "Upon timely request for an extension of the 180-day deadline in Regulation No. 66-01, the Commission's Executive Director may grant a maximum extension of 31 days." Having been filed three weeks after the March 6, 2017, deadline, applicant's request is not timely. The request, therefore, is denied.
