By application filed April 27, 2017, Metropolitanlimousine, LLC, seeks voluntary termination of Certificate No. 2325.

The Executive Director may approve an application for voluntary termination under Regulation No. 54-08(d). The application shall be denied if applicant is not in good standing with the Commission.<sup>1</sup>

Each carrier holding a certificate of authority on the first day of the calendar year must file an annual report and pay an annual fee on or before January 31 of that year.<sup>2</sup> Applicant held Certificate No. 2325 on January 1 of this year but has yet to pay its annual fee or file an acceptable annual report. Applicant also owes \$300 in late fees pursuant to Regulation No. 67-03. Consequently, applicant is not in good standing.

Until such time as applicant has complied with Regulation Nos. 60 and 67 by filing an acceptable 2017 annual report, paying its \$175 annual fee for 2017, and paying \$300 in late fees, a request for voluntary termination shall not be approved.<sup>3</sup>

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the application of Metropolitanlimousine, LLC, for voluntary termination of Certificate No. 2325 is hereby denied without prejudice.
