Certificate No. 2770 was automatically suspended on May 31, 2017, pursuant to Regulation No. 58-12, for respondent's willful failure to maintain on file with the Commission proof of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit, motor vehicle liability insurance as required by Commission Regulation No. 58. Order No. 17,027, served May 31, 2017, noted that Certificate No. 2770 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late fee within 30 days. Respondent has yet to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay the late fee.

In the meantime, Certificate No. 2770 was revoked in a separate proceeding in Order No. 17,030, served June 1, 2017, for respondent's failure to file a 2017 annual report, pay a \$175 annual fee for 2017, and pay \$300 in late fees assessed pursuant to Regulation No. 67-03(a),(b).¹

Inasmuch as respondent no longer holds WMATC authority and the period for requesting reconsideration of Order No. 17,030 has expired, this investigation is hereby terminated. The \$100 late insurance fee shall remain due in accordance with Regulation No. 67.
