

In Order No. 1008, issued January 22, 1970, D. C. Transit System, Inc., was granted 120-day temporary authority commencing February 2, 1970, to extend Route Y-6 to the Plaza del Mercado Shopping Center on Bel Pre Road. To get to the shopping center to begin the run, Y-6 buses proceed from Georgia Avenue over Glenallen Avenue and Layhill Road but at present do not pick up or discharge passengers there.

On February 6, 1970, D. C. Transit filed Application No. 608 requesting 105-day temporary authority to pick up and discharge passengers on the Y-6 line on Glenallen Avenue and Layhill Road. In support of its application, Transit stated that it had received requests from the public to operate such service.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 608 of D. C. Transit System, Inc., for 105-day temporary authority to extend Route Y-6 be, and it is hereby, granted, effective February 17, 1970.
