
Formal Complaint No. 23

On November 21, 1969, the Alexandria, Barcroft and Washington Transit Company (A. B. & W.) and the Washington, Virginia and Maryland Coach Company (W. V. & M.) filed Formal Complaint No. 23 against WMA Transit Company (WMA) alleging that WMA was performing common carrier, regular route bus passenger operations without proper Commission certification, seeking a cease and desist order. On December 8, 1969, WMA filed a formal answer to that complaint.

The three companies involved submitted on February 9, 1970, a formal stipulation and joint request for dismissal. We find that no issue raised by Formal Complaint No. 23 requires additional consideration at this time.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Formal Complaint No. 23 be, and it is hereby, dismissed.
