Greyhound Airport Service, Inc. filed, on March 2, 1970, Supplement No. 1 to its WMATC Tariff No. 11, which contemplates institution of two new services beginning April 1, 1970.


The first new service is called a "Special Group Riding Sedan Service" and is to be operated between Dulles International Airport and any specific address in the Metropolitan District. Service will be provided with a station wagon for groups of up to eight passengers going to no more than five destination points within the general area designated. The service will be more economical than taxicab, but not as inexpensive as bus transportation. It is being initiated in response to a request from the Federal Aviation Administration.

The second new service is a special, express service between Washington National Airport and 15th and E Streets, N. W. The downtown location was selected because of its central location, convenient to government installations and commercial businesses. The proposed fare is one dollar. Greyhound asserts that the institution of economical express airport service will provide airline passengers with better service than is presently available. Again, this service is in response to a request from the Federal Aviation Administration. The new service will use a limousine or small bus, depending on demand.

The Commission is interested in receiving the views of anyone having an interest in this matter.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that any interested person may submit his views regarding the two proposed services described in Greyhound Airport Service, Inc. WMATC Tariff No. 11, Supplement No. 1, to the Commission, in writing, no later than 15 days from the date of this order, at Room 316, 1625 I Street, Northwest, Washington, D. C. 20006.
