On April 16, 1970, Greyhound Airport Service, Inc., filed Application No. 620 requesting permission to increase its existing taxicab fares between Washington National and Dulles International Airports, and points within the Washington Metropolitan District. Under the company's request, the present fare of \$.60 for the first mile and \$.25 for each additional half mile would be increased to \$.60 for the first one third of a mile and \$.20 for each additional third of a mile. Waiting time charges would also be increased.

Applicant alleged it is in a difficult financial position, and requested that the Commission permit the proposed increases to become effective immediately. Although we intend to take action on this application as soon as possible, we feel that the public should have adequate opportunity to comment on the proposed increases.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That a hearing on the proposed fare increase be held in the hearing room of the Commission, 1625 I Street, N. W., Room 314, Washington, D. C., on Thursday, May 21, 1970, at 2:00 p.m.

2. That applicant publish notice of the proposed increase and the hearing thereon in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District no later than ten (10) days before the hearing date.

3. That interested persons desiring to be heard on this matter shall so indicate, in writing, to the Commission, with a copy to applicant's attorney of record, L. C. Major, Esquire, 421 King Street, Suite 301, Alexandria, Virginia, at least two (2) days prior to said hearing.
