In Order No. 990, issued November 17, 1969, we granted to D. C. Transit System, Inc., 180-day temporary authority to operate Routes 0-7 and 0-9 in the manner fully described in that order.

These routes are being operated under the auspices of the Metropolitan Council of Governments. COG has agreed to reimburse D. C. Transit for any losses incurred and to provide a reasonable rate of return to D. C. Transit for a total period of 18 months from the time the service began in November 1969, except that the agreement provides for earlier termination under certain specified circumstances. In Application No. 624, Transit has applied to operate the service for the full term of the agreement.

As we indicated in our Order No. 997 concerning other COG-sponsored bus service, we recognize the possibility that the need for the service and/or the ability to carry it on will change and will expect that some amendment to it may be necessary in the future.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the application of D. C. Transit System, Inc., for authority to amend its certificate to add Routes 0-7 and 0-9 be, and it is hereby, granted.

2. That Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 5 be, and it is hereby, amended by incorporating Fourth Revised Page 11, cancelling Third Revised Page 11 and Third Revised Page 11A, cancelling Second Revised Page 11A, as attached hereto and made a part hereof.

3. That the amendment authorized herein shall be effective May 16, 1970.
