In Application No. 617, filed March 27, 1970, D. C. Transit System, Inc., requested temporary authority to operate experimental bus service between the Metroliner Station at the Beltway in Lanham, Maryland, and points in Rockville, Bethesda and Silver Spring in Montgomery County under the auspices of the U. S. Department of Transportation.


By Order No. 1034, issued April 3, 1970, we granted the request for temporary authority, noting that WMA Transit Company had filed a protest in opposition. We said at that time that we would set a hearing to consider the issues raised.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That a hearing to consider Application No. 617 of D. C. Transit System, Inc., for temporary authority to operate an experimental bus service between the high speed railroad station in Lanham, Maryland and points and places in Montgomery County, Maryland, be, and it is hereby, scheduled for Thursday, June 4, 1970, at 10:00 A. M. in the Commission Hearing Room, 1625 I Street, N. W., Room 314, Washington, D. C. 20006.

2. That applicant publish notice of the proposed hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District no later than fifteen (15) days prior to said hearing.
